## Trust in the Lord

Solomon wrote: "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths" (Proverbs 3:5-6). What do we learn from these powerful verses?

We learn that our lives are to be built around God. The wise man Solomon said, "Trust in the Lord." He also told us how deep our trust should be. He stated, "with all thine heart." Partial trust in God is not even recognized. Solomon said, "with all thine heart"

This passage in Proverbs also shows us that our human wisdom is ineffective. The verse says, "lean not unto thine own understanding." We often hear people ask, "What do you think?" or "What's your view?" Human thinking and opinions do not match up to what God says. We should ask, "What does God say in His Word?" and not "What do you think?" The prophet Jeremiah stated, "O Lord, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his steps" (Jeremiah 10:23). No church council, group of men, book of theology, or human creed can replace one sacred page of God's Word.

Solomon tells us how we should live: "In all thy ways acknowledge him." This means we acknowledge God in our homes, on the job, in our neighborhoods, at various clubs and organizations, and in our own congregation. We must place God at the center of every part of our life. Someone said, "Christ must be Lord of all, or He is not Lord at all." There is much truth in that statement."

The passage in Proverbs concludes: "And he shall direct thy paths." If we put God first in our hearts and lives, He will guide our lives. He does this through His Word and His providential care.

"O how sweet to trust in Jesus, just to take Him at His Word." A life of trusting in the Lord is a life of peace and security.
