Calling On the Name of the Lord

The apostle Paul made this statement: "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Romans 10:13). What is Paul saying about salvation in this passage?

First, Paul gives the scope of salvation. He said, "Whosoever." The inspired apostle did not say that salvation was only for the Jews or only for the Gentiles. The Bible says God wants all men to be saved (I Timothy 2:4) and that all should come to repentance (II Peter 3:9). Paul emphasized this point in the first chapter of Romans when he said that the gospel is "the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth: to the Jew first, and also to the Greek" (Romans 1:16).

Secondly, Paul shows that salvation is conditional. Salvation is by grace (Ephesians 2:8-9), but it is also not by grace only, because grace teaches us how to live (Titus 2:11-12). The Scriptures teach that Jesus saves the obedient believer (Hebrews 5:8-9).

Thirdly, Paul gives the "how" of being saved, i.e. "by calling on the name of the Lord." To call on the name of the Lord is not to merely audibly cry out "Lord, Lord" or to pray for salvation. Jesus had already made that clear in the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 7:21-22). One cannot call on the name of the Lord unless one believes, and one cannot believe without hearing the gospel (Romans 10:13-17). In verse 13, Paul used the phrase "calling on the name of the Lord," and in verse 16, he used the phrase "obey the gospel." Therefore, the two phrases are used synonymously in the context. Luke recorded the words of Ananias to Paul: "And now why tarriest thou? Arise and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord" (Acts 22:16).

Salvation is important because it involves being saved from the consequences of sin (Romans 6:23). Let us all encourage everyone we know to call on the name of the Lord by believing in Christ, repenting of sins, confessing one's faith, and being baptized for the forgiveness of sins.
