The Unchanging Christ

The Hebrew writer declared: "Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, and today, and forever" (Hebrews 13:8). In the midst of all the changes in life, people long for something that is constant and unchanging. Jesus Christ does not change. This being the case implies some truths about Christ which do not change.

The words of salvation spoken by the Lord have not changed (Hebrews 2:1-4). Salvation is the deliverance from the power and effects of sin, and salvation was proclaimed by the Lord (Hebrews 2:3). In order to learn what one must do to be saved from sin, one must listen to Jesus (John 14:6). Jesus gave the conditions which one must obey in order to obtain this salvation (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:46-47). Throughout the New Testament, the conditions for salvation are the same for everyone: faith, repentance, confession of faith, and baptism for the remission of sins.

Another truth which has not changed is the Kingdom of Christ (Hebrews 12:28). In the Lord's Kingdom, there is redemption and the forgiveness of sins (Colossians 1:13-14). One should understand that the kingdom is the church (Matthew 16:18-19; Colossians 1:13-18). Christ is the eternal King over His everlasting kingdom.

The promises of Christ will never change. The Lord promised to always be with His people (Matthew 28:20). He also promised that He would come again (Hebrews 9:28). Certainly, the judgment day is a promise which Christ will keep (Hebrews 9:27; Matthew 25:31-46; II Corinthians 5:10).

In the midst of change, confusion, and conflict, some things never change. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. "Hold to God's Unchanging Hand."
