### **A Serious Warning**

Paul stated: "I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed" (Galatians 1:6-9). What do we learn from these verses? There are many lessons, but some of them are as follows:

First, there is truth, and there is error. By saying that one could "pervert the gospel," Paul is implying that there is a certain "truth" which should <u>not</u> be perverted. In the world today, some people deny that there is such a thing as truth. Quite often, one's feelings are the standard for ethics, when Paul shows from this passage that the standard for ethics is truth.

Second, one must watch out for falsehoods. If distinguishing truth from error is not important, one must ask why Paul would even make such a statement as found in Galatians one. Paul's statement to the Galatians shows the importance of truth.

Third, falsehoods can come from various sources. Paul mentions two of them in this passage - from men or from angels. Paul shows us that even an angelic appearance could be a perversion of the gospel if truth is not being taught. Paul said that even Satan himself can appear to be an angel of light (II Corinthians 11:14).

Fourth, false doctrine taught and believed has eternal consequences. Paul said that those who preach another gospel are to be accursed (or condemned). Some brethren are downplaying the importance of true and false doctrine, but Paul reminds us that falsehood can condemn a soul.

Let us all heed Paul's words and strive to always adhere to the true gospel - the gospel of Christ.
