The inspired psalmist said: "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge. There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard" (Psalms 19:1-3). What is David telling us?

First, from the physical universe, one can see the existence of a divine being. The material evidence in nature shows us that there is a superior spiritual being, which is God.

Second, the physical creation shows the wisdom and infinite intelligence of God. David said, "the firmament sheweth his handywork." The idea behind these words is that the physical world shows design and purpose. It is not a hodge-podge of mixed up chemicals. The earth, sky, and stars all show design, and design implies a designer, who is God.

Third, the physical world implies the designer, during the day and at night. We see the glory of God during the day, when we easily see nature in all its splendor. We also see the glory of God at night, when we observe the moon and the starry night.

Fourth, the evidence for God is seen in nature throughout the entire world. David said, "There is no speech nor language where their voice is not heard." All people on earth are in contact with nature and, therefore, can reason their way to a supreme being. Certainly, without the Word of God, people would not know how to be saved. However, people everywhere can look at the natural world, and by using correct reasoning, deduce that there is a God.

May we all come to appreciate the glories and beauties of nature and the fact that the "heavens declare the glory of God."
