The Devil's Desire

The apostle Peter wrote: "Be sober, be vigilant, because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour" (I Peter 5:8). What is the inspired apostle telling us?

First, Peter is saying that the devil is real. He is not a myth or a made up character. He is just as real as all of us.

Second, Peter lets us know that the devil is not our friend. Peter describes the devil as our adversary. Being in an adversarial position means that anything that is a characteristic of God or Christ, will be just the opposite with the devil. God is characterized as truth, goodness, and happiness. Satan's characteristics are lying, evil, and sadness. Truly, the devil is our adversary.

Third, the devil is active. Peter says that he "walks about." Several modern translations translate it "prowls about like a roaring lion." This certainly brings out the nature of the devil. He will wait for just the right opportunity and then pounce on the unsuspecting Christian. Just like a lion waiting for his unsuspecting prey, Satan is waiting to attack the child of God.

Fourth, Peter relates the intention of the devil. He says that Satan is seeking whom he may devour. The word "devour" really means to destroy or totally overcome. Satan lied to Eve about God and attacked God's Word (Genesis 3:4,5). The tempter convinced Eve that God had withheld something good from her. However, the Lord had not withheld anything good from Adam and Eve. Satan tempted Eve, and she succumbed to the temptation. The devil wants every person to give in to sin and thereby lose his soul. Jesus taught that nothing is more important than your soul (Matthew 16:26).

Peter tells us how to overcome the devil. He began the verse by saying, "Be sober, be vigilant." One must be alert to the devil's attacks and his tricks (II Corinthians 2:11). Make no mistake, we are in a war. Our enemy is real and powerful. However, God is the most powerful being in the universe, and by relying on His help, we shall overcome the evil one.
