Calling on the Name of the Lord

Paul declared to the Roman brethren: "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Romans 10:13). What does it mean to "call on the name of the Lord?"

First, it does not mean that one simply audibly calls out the name of the Lord. Many people misuse the name of the Lord and call it out in an act of profanity.

Second, it does not mean that one can claim Jesus as Lord and then disobey His commands. Christ asked this question: "And why call ye me Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?" (Luke 6:46). Any person who says, "Lord, save me," and yet refuses to do what Jesus commanded, is in the class of the disobedient. He may use the word "Lord," but he is definitely not pleasing to God.

Third, Paul uses the term "calling on the name of the Lord" (Romans 10:13) in the same context as "obeying the gospel" (Romans 10:16). The gospel has facts to be believed (I Corinthians 15:1-3). It also has commands to be obeyed (Mark 16:15-16; Romans 10:16; II Thessalonians 1:7-9). The commands of the gospel are: believe (Acts 16:31, repent (Acts 17:30-31), confess your faith (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized (Acts 2:38). The gospel also has blessings to be enjoyed.

Fourth, when Paul was healed by Ananias, he was told, "And now why tarriest thou? Arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord" (Acts 23:16). This should settle that calling on the name of the Lord involves being baptized into Christ for the remission of sins.

Let us all encourage all of our friends, neighbors, relatives, co-workers, and everyone we know to call on the name of the Lord by believing in Christ, repenting of sins, confessing one's faith, and being baptized into Christ.
