Love Thy Neighbor as Thyself

Jesus stated that the first and greatest commandment is to love God with all your heart, soul, and mind (Matthew 22:37). Following this, our Savior said, "And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself" (Matthew 22:39). What does it mean to love one's neighbor?

First of all, there are negative aspects of loving one's neighbor. Paul dealt with this subject and stated it this way: "For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. Love worketh no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law" (Romans 13:8-10). If we love our neighbors, we will do them no harm, because we would not want to harm ourselves.

There are also positive aspects of loving one's neighbor. One should be respectful of every person and have no prejudice (James 2:8-9). It also means that one will not gossip about his neighbor (Galatians 5:13-15). It certainly means that one will serve his neighbor (Galatians 5:13).

If one loves his neighbor, he will do his best in times of emergency to meet his neighbor's physical needs (I John 3:17-18). It will also mean that one will try to help meet his neighbor's emotional needs (I Thessalonians 5:14). It will mean that we are attuned to our neighbor's spiritual needs (Mark 16:15-16; Galatians 6:1). Certainly, loving our neighbor means we behave honestly with him (Ephesians 4:25).

Our love for God and our love for our neighbor are not separated. Rather they are uniquely joined together (Mark 12:28-32). True righteousness is not simply following rituals but rather embracing God in the deepest way in worship and in reaching out to our fellow man.


