A Shadow, but Not the Real Thing

The apostle Paul warned that in the last days, people would be guilty of numerous sins (II Timothy 3:1-5). One of the sins Paul mentions is that people would be "having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof" (verse 5). Basically, Paul is saying that their religion would be one of externals. How does this apply to us today?

In the Old Testament, there was a time when the wrong items were emphasized. The prophet Micah taught that people were more interested in external rituals than internal righteousness (Micah 6:6-8). In Jesus' day, people were guilty of the same thing (Matthew 15:8-9). An external religion is one of lip service, but the heart is not involved. This has never been pleasing to God. Sometimes, when people are only concerned about external religion, Christianity is reduced to "churchianity." What happens is that some folks "go to church" but then do as they please. One may attend a worship service with an impenitent heart and then leave the same way. This is the "form of godliness but denying the power thereof."

The results of this practice of external religion are disastrous. Many people who observe the "external Christian" turn away in disgust. Most people are aware of the fact that rote ritual is as empty as no worship at all. Some people try to substitute some other aspect of Christianity for a sincere, whole-hearted relationship with God.

God's basic solution to this problem is succinctly given in the book of Revelation, when the Lord told the church at Ephesus: "Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works" (Revelation 2:5). The Lord said to remember, repent, and respond. This is what will cure the problem of external Christianity. People are not really changed unless they are changed in their hearts. A very popular hymn is entitled "Is Thy Heart Right with God?" This is the basic question and the basic issue.

Externals do matter in our relationship with God, but without the internals being right, we have only a "form of godliness."
