Christ Is the Way

Our Lord made a wonderful statement when He declared: "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me" (John 14:6). By saying that He is the way, Jesus is saying "follow me" (cf. Matthew 16:24). Why should people follow Jesus?

People should follow Jesus because He is the way out of darkness. Christ functions in this capacity as the light of the world (John 8:12). The Bible often uses "darkness" to describe sin (John 1:5; 3:19-20). Quite often, people do not know the consequences of sin because they are spiritually blind. They are blind to the suffering sin causes in this life and to the eternal suffering sin will cause. Christ said that those who follow Him will not abide in darkness (John 12:46).

People should follow Jesus because He is the way out of religious confusion. Jesus is this because He is the truth. The Pharisees and the Sadducees in Jesus' day were in error (Matthew 22:23-40). Christ taught that people could know the truth (John 8:31-33). It is very popular to say that no one can know the truth, and therefore no one is ever wrong. However, Jesus said people can know the truth and that the truth can set them free (John 8:32). One follows the truth by following Christ's Word (John 14:15).

People should follow Jesus because He is the way out of despair. He is that because He is the life. Our world is full of people who see life as just a world of despondency and despair. However, Jesus said that He came to this world of sin and sorrow so that people could "have life and have it more abundantly" (John 10:10). Christ gives meaning and purpose to life so that people can live for something greater than themselves.

If we follow Jesus (the Way), He will lead us to God and to the ultimate victory.
