# A Christ-like Response

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus declared: "Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbor, and hate thine enemy. But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you" (Matthew 5:43-44). The apostle Paul taught the same idea. He wrote, "Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not" (Romans 12:14). He went on to say Christians are to "Recompense to no man evil for evil' (vs. 17). Paul concluded this chapter by saying, "Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good" (vs. 21). What do we conclude from these passages?

To begin with, Christians are to think differently than the world does. Because we follow a different leader (Christ), we must think differently, speak differently, and act differently. The world would say that it is just normal to get back at someone when they have hurt or offended you. However, Christ commands us to be different from the world. If we try to avenge ourselves, the other party will try to get an even greater vengeance. Where will it stop?

Also, we have the example of Jesus. When the Jewish leaders incited the people to demand the crucifixion of Jesus, Christ did not retaliate while on the cross. He said, "Father forgive them; for they know not what they do" (Luke 23:34). God did forgive those Jews on the day of Pentecost when they repented and were baptized for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38). It is true that, as the song says, Christ could have "called 10,000 angels, but he died alone for you and me." Jesus had every right to lash out and strike down the murderous Jews and tormenting Romans, but He did not.

We should also remember that God has put the burden of vengeance and punishment on civil government. Paul said that the government acts as a minster of God (Romans 13:4). The justice system may be far from perfect, but governments are ordained of God (Romans 13:1), and we must realize that their role of executing vengeance is part of God's plan.

Brethren, let us all do our best to return good for evil and, thereby, follow the example of our Lord.
