## Points to Remember in Bible Study

It is a wonderful experience to study God's Word and to be refreshed by its deep spiritual teachings. There are several points that one should consider as one studies the Scriptures.

First, who is speaking in a particular passage? Is it God or man? Several times in the Bible, Satan is the speaker. While the record of the speaker (the Bible itself) is inspired, the speaker himself (uninspired men, demons, or the devil) may not be inspired.

Second, we need to pay attention to what is being said. Is it a command or statement from God, or is it just a comment from an uninspired person? We must understand that the Bible records statements that are from uninspired sources. Sometimes, there are historical statements to clarify a time frame.

Third, what is the time frame for the passage being studied? Is it in the Patriarchal age, when God spoke to the fathers? Is it in the Mosaic age, when the law was given by Moses? Was it in the Christian age, when Christ speaks to the whole world? God told Noah to build the ark (Genesis 6). However, this command of God does not apply to us today. The Israelites were commanded to remember the Sabbath Day (Exodus 20:8). However, nowhere in the Christian age are God's people commanded to honor the Sabbath.

Fourth, why was a particular statement made? Was the statement or command given to an alien sinner (repent and be baptized)? Was it a command given to an erring brother (repent and pray for forgiveness)? Was the statement made to correct a problem in a congregation (let there be no divisions among you)? Was it the application of a universal principle (love one another)? Was it made to reflect on the nature of God (be ye holy, for I am holy)? Why was the statement made?

There are many other principles that need to be learned if one is going to be a serious Bible student, but these should help all of us to begin our studies and increase our knowledge of God's Word.


