# The Importance of Studying the Bible

In II Timothy 4:13, Paul is giving some final instructions to Timothy. Paul is in prison and feels that his time on earth is very limited (II Timothy 4:6). He asks of Timothy: "The cloke that I left at Troas with Carpus, when thou comest, bring with thee, and the books, but especially the parchments." We may not know exactly which books and parchments Paul was referring to. Possibly, it was Old Testament books, such as Psalms, that he needed for comfort. Perhaps it was some of the New Testament books, such as one of the Gospel accounts so that he might take strength from reading about the trials of Jesus. Maybe it was another book of Scripture. The truth is, we simply do not know. But this much we do know . . . at the end of his life, Paul felt the need to have access to books so that he could read and study them. If the great apostle Paul needed to study, then how could any of us possibly say we do not need to study? Even though it was the end of Paul's life, he still wanted to have books and parchments to read. What a tremendous example for every child of God.

There are so many wonderful attributes provided by God's Word. God's Word produces faith (John 20:30-31; Romans 10:17). A study of God's Word makes one noble (Acts 17:11). God's Word provides comfort (Romans 15:4). God's Word provides excellent examples (I Corinthians 10:11). God's Word provides the full armor for a Christian (Ephesians 6:11-17). The Word of God makes us wise unto salvation (II Timothy 3:15). The Word of God discerns the thoughts and intents of the heart (Hebrews 4:12). Many other attributes and spiritual blessings could be cited, but surely we can all see the wonderful growth that will take place when we study the Sacred Volume.

May we all resolve to attend as many Bible studies as possible and also do all we can privately to learn as much of the Scripture as we can.


