The Feeling of Forgiveness

Following his adultery with Bathsheba, King David was confronted by Nathan the prophet in regard to his sin (II Samuel 12:1-14). David admitted his sin to Nathan and later composed Psalm 51 to show his feelings of guilt and subsequent forgiveness by God. In this psalm, David makes many important points that can apply to every person.

In verse three, David said, "For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me." When we confront someone with sin in their life, one of the hardest things is getting them to admit to their sin. People often get defensive and many times even rationalize that their behavior was not sinful.

David also sees how deep and personal God's forgiveness is. In verse seven, he pleaded with God to "Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I will be whiter than snow." Sin causes one to feel dirty, because sin is "spiritual dirt." One needs a complete washing to remove the filth in one's life. When one is forgiven by the Lord, his soul is "whiter than snow."

The sweet singer of Israel also knew the feelings that come over a person when they are forgiven. David used the words "clean heart" (vs. 10), "a right spirit" (vs. 10), "the joy of thy salvation" (vs. 12), and "thy free spirit" (vs. 12). The psalmist obviously knew what a joyous and uplifting feeling one has when he is forgiven. It is as if a weight has been lifted from your shoulders.

King David also stated how one shows his appreciation to God for wiping away our sins. He said, "I will teach transgressors thy ways" (vs. 13), "my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness (vs. 14), and "my mouth shall shew forth thy praise" (vs. 15). When one experiences complete forgiveness from God, one cannot help but tell others about the mercy of God and the cleansing of sin from one's life.

The Bible teaches that there will be isolated times of sin in our lives (I John 1:8), but if we confess our sins, we know God will forgive them (I John 1:9). It is then that we can experience the feeling of forgiveness that King David found long ago.


