Be Filled With the Spirit

The positive response to the series on the “Works of the Flesh” and the “Fruit of the Spirit” has been very encouraging. We want to conclude this series with a summation of the second list – the Fruit of the Spirit found in Galatians 5:22-25.

Love is the ability to go beyond one’s self and seek the good of others. Sometimes it means even making great sacrifices for others if necessary.

Joy is an inner satisfaction and delight that comes from a secure relationship with God.

Peace is the ability to live in serenity with God, self, and other people.

Patience (longsuffering, KJV) is the power to bear with people and circumstances, even in the worst trying times.

Kindness (gentleness KJV) is the willingness to be involved in another person’s needs in order to help meet them.

Goodness is upright and honorable conduct. It would include a generous and charitable spirit.

Faithfulness (faith, KJV) is the quality of utter dependability, reliability, and loyalty.

Gentleness (meekness, KJV) is strength under divine control. It is not a weakness but rather being under the control of God so that one can accomplish His goals.

Self control (temperance, KJV) is the power to restrain oneself from forces, appetites, and feelings that can enslave, harm, or ruin you.

Paul said in regard to these qualities: “against such there is no law.” The inspired apostle encouraged the brethren to “walk in the spirit” (Galatians 5:25). He also told the Ephesian saints to “be filled with the Spirit” (Ephesians 5:18). One is filled with the Spirit by following the Spirit’s teaching (the Word of God) and by bearing the fruit of the Spirit.
