Having the Proper Attitude

Our Savior made a marvelous declaration in the Gospel of John. He stated: "My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me. If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself. He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but he that seeketh his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him" (John 7:16-18). In regard to Jesus' doctrine, our Lord said that if any man "will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God." This comes down to a matter of attitude. Do we really *want* to know if a particular doctrine is of God (i.e. Is it true)?

The contemporary idea is that doctrine is not important and every doctrine is equally true. This really is the view that truth (or doctrine) is in the mind of the beholder and created by the individual. This is pure subjectivism. While it is the case that some areas of life are very subjective (i.e. art, beauty, food), this does not mean that everything is subjective. One could never say that chemistry, mathematics, medicine, physics, human anatomy, the alphabet, or any number of other areas are subjective. They are objective and have objective truth. One could never say "to me two plus two are five, while to you two plus two are four." One can know truth (John 8:32), and one must love truth (II Thessalonians 2:10).

This comes back to Jesus' statement: Do we really want to know if His doctrine is from God? Our modern society is so blinded by ignorance, indifference, and selfishness that it has almost totally done away with any "will to know His doctrine, whether it be of God."

May God grant us the strength to preach the saving message of Jesus, and we pray that people will *want* to know His doctrine. It is all a matter of attitude.


