Thy Word is Truth

Jesus made the statement: "Thy word is truth" (John 17:17). Whenever Jesus referred to the Scriptures (God's Word), it was clear that He saw them as truth. This applies to both the New and Old Covenant Scripture. The emphasis on truth is found throughout the Bible.

Paul said that one must love the truth. To the Thessalonian brethren, Paul wrote that some people would perish "because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved" (II Thessalonians 2:10). If one does not want truth more than anything else, then he has built his life upon the fickleness of subjectivism. This is the same idea that King Solomon conveyed when he wrote: "Buy the truth and sell it not" (Proverbs 23:23). Therefore, one must love the truth above friends, family, traditions, or cultural viewpoints.

Besides loving the truth, one must recognize the significance of truth in one's spiritual life. Jesus taught that we are sanctified by the truth (John 17:17). Our freedom comes by knowing the truth (John 8:32). Our worship must be done in truth (John 4:24). We have been purified by obeying the truth (I Peter 1:22-23). We are established (made stable) by the truth (II Peter 1:12). Truth is part of the Christian armor (Ephesians 6:14). God's judgment will be according to truth (Romans 2:2). From these Scriptures, it would certainly be foolish and contrary to God's Word to say that truth does not matter. It is an absolute necessity if we are to follow the Lord's way.

The most fundamental characteristic of the church today is its attitude toward God's Word. God's Word is truth (John 17:17), and we must never let any person, group, or religious figure cause us to forget this fact.
