Rightly Dividing the Word

Paul told the young evangelist Timothy: "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (Il Timothy 2:15). All people need to know how to "rightly divide the word of truth." Many people never learn the basic divisions of the Bible and therefore conclude that it is a confusing book. Unless we know how to divide it, we can never learn the truth.

One must see that there are two great divisions in the Bible, the Old and New Testaments. The New Testament is not just a continuation of the Old Testament. They are two very different covenants, and we are not under the Old Covenant.

The Scriptures make it very plain that the Old Law (Testament) ended with the death of Christ (Romans 7:4; Ephesians 2:14-15; Colossians 2:14). The Hebrew writer declares, "He taketh away the first that he may establish the second" (Hebrews 10:9). The Old Testament itself had foretold that there would be another covenant (Deuteronomy 18:15-18; Jeremiah 31:31-34).

The New Covenant went into effect following the death of Christ (Hebrews 9:16-17) on the first Pentecost after the crucifixion (Acts 2:1-4). After the New Testament was in effect, no part of the Old Testament (such as the Sabbath, incense, or instrumental music) was ever enjoined upon people.

May all people see the distinction between the Old and New Testaments and come to understand that we live under the New Testament today. It should be our prayer that all people will learn more of God's will and apply it to their lives.
