# John's Gospel

The apostle John gave the purpose of his gospel when he stated: "And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name" (John 20:30-31). What do we learn from these verses of Scripture?

First, John did not include everything that could be written about Christ. There were other signs (miracles) that John did not mention. John also did not write about Jesus' parables, beatitudes, and many individual conversations. This does not mean that John's gospel is deficient in any way. It just means that these parables, beatitudes, etc. were not within the scope of John's gospel.

Second, John gave the reason for his record of Jesus' miracles: "that you might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God." From this text, we see that the recording of miracles *can* produce faith. Some modern-day preachers claim that no one can believe in Christ today unless they see a miracle. Yet, John affirms just the opposite. People can read the record of miracles and, because of the signs, believe in Jesus.

Third, having read about the miracles and having come to faith in Christ, one can then have "life in his name." One can have the abundant life (John 10:10) through Christ. Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6), and John stated that eternal life only comes from knowing God and Jesus Christ (John 17:3).

May all people realize the beauty of John's gospel and the transforming power it can have in one's life.
