The Great Physician

Paul had a thorn in the flesh (II Corinthians 12:7-9). Timothy had stomach problems (I Timothy 5:23). Paul left Trophimus at Miletus because he was ill (II Timothy 4:20). Jesus mentions physicians in a proverb (Luke 4:23). Our Lord talked about healthy people not needing a physician (Matthew 9:12; Mark 2:17; Luke 5:31). Luke is called "the beloved physician" (Colossians 4:14). There are so many references in Scripture to Jesus healing people that we cannot list them all here.

Possibly the most important reference to healing in God's Word is the comparison of sin to disease or sickness. Israel is said to be in need of "healing" because of their sins (Psalms 6:2; Psalms 41:4; Hosea 7:1; Hosea 14:4). Isaiah 53:5 says the coming Messiah will bring healing, and this verse is later cited by Peter (I Peter 2:24).

When we are sick, we all long to be well again. We take whatever medications the doctors prescribe, do whatever they tell us to do, refrain from any bad habits, etc. We should do the same with the "Great Physician." As the old hymn beautifully says: "Sweetest note in seraph song, Sweetest name on mortal tongue, Sweetest carol ever sung, Jesus, blessed Jesus." He is the only cure for the worst disease in the world - sin. Let us be thankful that Jesus is the "Great Physician."


