Paul spoke of the “spirit of unity in the bond of peace” (Ephesians 4:3-6). When a congregation of the Lord’s people are engaged in arguing, fussing, and fighting, the Lord’s work cannot progress. We know that Jesus prayed for unity (John 17:20-22), and Paul condemned division (I Corinthians 1:10). How do we achieve the unity God desires?

We must actively seek peace. Peter said we must “seek peace’ (I Peter 3:11). Christians must recognize that peace is to be the ruling principle in their hearts (Colossians 3:15). God’s servants are taught not to engage in strife for strife’s sake (II Timothy 2:24-26).

Many times in a congregation, strife and disunity arise in matters of opinion. In areas of judgment and opinion, we must always try to please others rather than ourselves (I Corinthians 10:32-33). Love is not selfish (I Corinthians 13:5).

Even though peace and harmony are to be desired in every church, we must not seek peace at the expense of truth (II John 9:11; Jude 3; Matthew 15:9).

God wants Christians to be at peace with all men (Romans 12:18). How much more important is this among brethren! Paul admonished us: “And be at peace among yourselves” (I Thessalonians 5:13). May we all seek God’s peace in our congregation and work toward that end.
